## ST GABRIELS CHURCH- DIRECTIONS

Havant Rd , London, E17 3JF



Havant Road is ONE-WAY from west to east. Parking is available – but be careful only to park in spaces allocated to the Church (or park in local street)

The walk from **Walthamstow Central** takes around 15 minutes and the most pleasant way to walk is along St Mary Road and Church Lane.

The 212 bus runs from Walthamstow Central along Church Hill/Prospect Hill/Shernhall Street (from Walthamstow Central) and the last stop along Prospect Hill is probably the closest. The 275 from Walthamstow Central runs along Forest Road

The 123 from Blackhorse Road runs along Forest Road and the W16 runs along from Leytonstone and along Wood Street past Havant Road.

**Wood Street** station has trains to/from Liverpool Street every 15 minutes during the weekday evenings [www.nationalexpresseastanglia.com/](http://www.nationalexpresseastanglia.com/)
